



Want to become a Board Member?

At this year's Annual General Meeting (AGM) on **Friday June 20, 2025**, members will be voting to fill at least two (2) Board positions.

Who is eligible?

You must be a current 2025 member **AND** have been a WAC member for at least one year. This means that you must have become a member on or before June 21, 2024. All 2025 members of WAC can vote at the Annual General Meeting (AGM), but only those who have been a WAC member for at least one year are eligible to run for a position on the Board.

What does the Board do?

WAC has a strong Management Team that manages WAC's day-to-day organization, staffing, finances and programming. The main role of the Board of Directors is to review reports from the Management Team and to assist in the development of policies and procedures to help direct our work and how we work together. Examples are: "Policy to Prevent Discrimination and Harassment" and "Personnel Policy".

This is a **volunteer position** for those who are passionate about supporting WAC. Ideally you would have some previous experience in non-profit administration – but this is also a great opportunity to develop your skills and knowledge. The Board meets about 5 times a year, at times that best suit the majority of the members. The term for a Board member is two years.

3. Be sure to attend the AGM on June 20, 2025. You will be asked to introduce yourself to the membership before the voting takes place.
